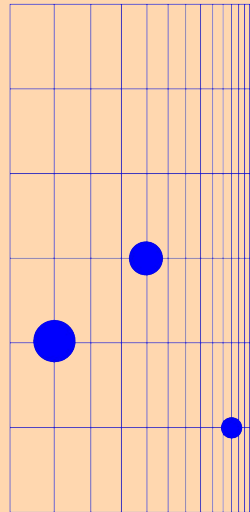
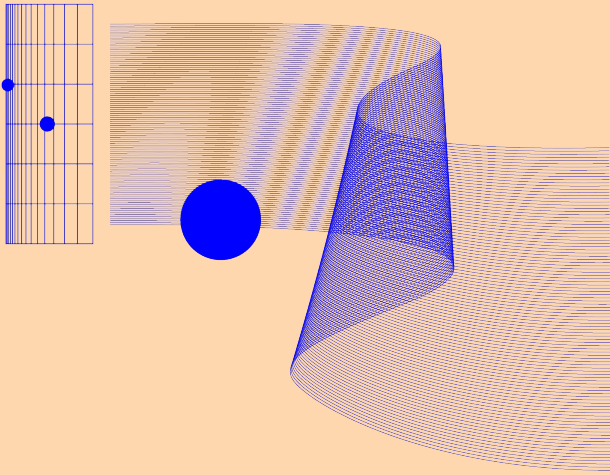

IN A NUTSHELL

We will develop six different and tangible solutions to real problems. Six multidisciplinary teams of young professionals from six metropolitan cities on six different continents will develop solutions for challenges that other cities experience due to climate change.

Each team focuses on a challenge proposed by the mayor from another city on a different continent. During the FOLLOW THE SUN estafette, our team of experts will guide the teams through the creative- and business development process to get to that tangible result. There will be daily digital briefings, workshops and lectures with all six teams and teams are constantly encouraged to remain in close contact with each other - even on the opposite side of the world. The results of all teams will be presented during the Summit TV to a large group of global leaders and changemakers, liaisons of the global C40.

WHAT DO WE ASK

We are looking for young or young-hearted, bright people that want to give it all during a one week, internationally oriented challenge. During the week, we will keep you busy for a minimum of 40 hours. Due to its global nature, you might also be working during early mornings or late evenings.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU

A lot! The chance to really contribute to one of the biggest challenges of our time: protecting our cities against climate change. You will also sharpen your skills and deepen your knowledge. You will build a very strong network, both domestically and globally, represented by global leaders, mayors, policy makers and local innovators.

DESIGN AND SHOWCASE YOUR IDEAS FOR THE WORLD STAGE AND TOP PLAYERS IN CLIMATE ADAPTATION

IN DEPTH

FOLLOW THE SUN will guide you through a few development phases to get to your solution, in a one-week deep-dive of creative and business development: ranging from an orientation phase to conceptualization to business development, to eventually, prototyping and showcasing your developed solution to a world stage.

SCHEDULE

FOLLOW THE SUN starts on Monday, January 18th. Each team gets a design-challenge laid out by the mayor of one of the other participating cities. During the kickoff you will be researching the context of the challenge your team has been given. You will be working together with experts from your own city and from the city whose challenge you are focusing on.

On the two following days, you will be developing possible solutions. We will provide design-thinkers, scientists and business-experts to guide you along the way. At the end of the third day, you will pick – together with the challenge-owners – the most promising solution.

On Thursdays and Friday, you will be refining your solution, making a business case and creating a tangible visualization or prototype that represents your solution.

On Monday, during the Climate Adaption Summit, you will pitch your solution to a global audience and the jury will choose one winner. Of course you will have time over the weekend to make it even better, but that's up to you.

There are daily online gatherings with all teams, from 03.00 – 04.00 PM Rotterdam Time (GMT +1). Each day, each team will present its progress and the other teams will give feedback, tips and tricks.

Before the start of FOLLOW THE SUN, we will facilitate meetups with your other team members. We will also prepare you with extensive background material to dive deeply into the challenge.

After FOLLOW THE SUN, we will discuss with each city and each team what opportunities there are to further develop the presented solutions.

MULTIDISCIPLINARY TEAMS

For each team we look for five bright, driven young professionals from one metropolitan city area: ranging from artists, scientists, environmentalists, psychologists, sociologists, business developers, engineers, architects, data scientists, or other. Together with local policy makers, and brief intervals of insights from your local mayor or high ranking officials we will assure each team has enough different knowledge and diverse characters to come up with brilliant solutions within the challenge timeframe.
